




### GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT HUNGARY, THE CITY OF SZOLNOK AND THE KISS JÓZSEF 86TH HELICOPTER WING

Population: 10 million Territory: 93.030 km2 Language: Hungarian Capital: BUDAPEST

Religion in Hungary has been dominated by forms of Christianity for centuries. According to the 2011 census 54.2% of the Hungarians declared to believe in Christianity, of whom 38.9% were Catholics (both Greek and Roman), 13.8% Protestants (11.6% were Calvinists and 2.2% were Lutherans), around 2% followed other religions, and 16.7% were nonbelievers. The climate of the area is continental, with hot summers following relatively mild winters. The region is one of the sunniest in Europe; the average precipitation is about 490 millimetres annually.



Szolnok is situated 100km south-east of BUDAPEST. HDF Kiss József 86th Helicopter Wing is 5kms south-east of SZOLNOK.

SZolnok (Hungarian pronunciation: ['solnok] is the county seat of Jász-Nagykun Szolnok County in central Hungary. Its location on the banks of the River Tisza, and River Zagyva at the heart of the Great Hungarian Plain, has made it an important cultural and economic crossroads for centuries.

Szolnok was named after the first steward of the city, Szaunik or Zounok. The town was first officially mentioned under the name Zounok in 1075.

It lies about 100 kilometres (62 miles) south-east from Budapest.

The population is 72.330.

In 2001, the population of Szolnok consisted of 98% Hungarian, 1% Gypsy, and 1% people of other nationalities (mainly German).
















# HDF KISS JÓZSEF 86TH HELICOPTER WING IS THE ORGANIZER UNIT OF 46TH WMPC

The training of the first pilot students started at the 'György Kilián' Aviation Officer School in 1949. The pilot and aviation technician training was reorganized in 1961. The Aviation Training Wing was formed in 1964. In 1971, a Reconnaissance Air Wing started ope-





They formed the aircraft basis for the formation of the Hungarian People's Army (HPA) 89th Mixed Airlift Wing on 1 May 1984. As of 1 October 2004, in line with NATO principles, the HDF 86th Szolnok Helicopter Wing was formed and reached full operational capability (FOC) as the successor organization to the HDF 87th Bakony Attack Helicopter Wing and the HDF 89th Szolnok Mixed Airlift Wing. In May 2005 the barracks adopted Lt. József Ittebei Kiss' name.

In 1st of January 2023 the organization names was formed as HDF Kiss József 86th Helicopter wing.




